 - A. Discuss and consider extending the Solar Moratorium. If the Select Board determines that the need for land use regulations to govern solar development in the Town still exists and that the Planning Board is making progress in developing such regulations, the Select Board may vote to extend the solar development moratorium for up to another 180-day period.

Town of Monson Special Town Meeting Warrant December 14, 2023

To Jade Grenier or any other resident in the Town of Monson, in the County of Piscataquis and the State of Maine.

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of



said Town of Monson, in the said county and state, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Monson Town Office, in said town, on Thursday, December 14, 2023 at five (5 p.m.) in the evening then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

Article 1

To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting and to be voted by written ballot.

Article 2

To see if the Town will:

- (1) Appropriate a sum not to exceed \$666,586 to acquire a new Fire Department truck, (the "Project"); and
- (2) Authorize the Select Board to allocate \$75,000 from the Fire Equipment Reserve to pay for a portion of the Project; and
- (3) Authorize the Treasurer and Chair of the Select Board to issue general obligation securities of the Town of Monson to finance the remaining costs of the Project in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$591,586, plus any additional premium, and the discretion to fix the date(s), maturity (ies), calls(s) for redemption, refunding(s), place(s) of payment, premium(s), form, and other details of said securities, including execution and delivery of said securities on behalf of the Town of Monson, to provide for the sale thereof, and to execute any and all other documents and agreements related thereto.
