- The planning board has turned over the comprehensive plan process to me. Now that the budget is passed, and capital projects plan is coming together I will be putting them in and then scheduling public comment sessions.
- Monson has its first professionally done zoning map. Working out a few kinks and then it will be posted online and a color one printed for the office and Code Officer.
- Have sent an email to the new IT firm, Snowpond Technology, about the onboarding process and stressed that we are looking to update or upgrade our equipment ASAP.
- A list of goals for the coming year has been submitted to the chair and will be discussed at a future meeting.
- The federal government released updated guidance as to how ARRP funds can be sent, we still have no received ours yet.
- There is a map available of what streets and road will have fiber after the upgrade is completed by premium choice. Most people can expect to be able sign up for service in about a year.
- With the donation of the dock, I am working on a new policy/rules for use.
