

**WARRANT AND NOTICE OF ELECTION

The municipal clerks of the above municipalities shall immediately notify the respective municipal officers. The municipal officers shall meet forthwith and countersign this warrant and notice of election. The municipal officers shall provide below for the respective municipal clerks to post or have posted this warrant and notice of election.

TO: Martha Gagnon, Town Clerk of Monson: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF MONSON

You are hereby notified that a District budget validation referendum election will be held at the Monson Gymnasium, 35 Greenville Road in the Town of Monson on Tuesday, June 14, 2022 for the purpose of determining the following articles:

- Article 1: Shall the Regional School Unit No. 68 budget for the 2022-2023 school year that was adopted at the district budget meeting on May 31, 2022 be approved?
- Article 2: Do you wish to continue the budget validation referendum process in Regional School Unit No. 68 for an additional three years?

INFORMATIONAL NOTE

A **yes** vote will require Regional School Unit No. 68 to continue to conduct a referendum to validate its annual school budget for the next three years.

A **no** vote will discontinue the budget validation referendum for at least three years and provide instead that the annual school budget shall be finally adopted at a meeting of the voters.


The voting on the foregoing Article shall be by secret ballot referendum.


The polls must be opened at 8:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.



A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.


