The trees should be delivered to the Monson Gym on Saturday, December 3, 2022 between 8 and 9 am to be placed in front of the gym, where they will remain until 3 pm that day.

The public can cast their vote for the most creative tree by placing a \$1.00 donation in a collection container in front of each tree (s). Ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 creative trees. All donations from this competition will go to the Kris Kringle's Market fund to purchase winter clothing for local children in need.
